



INDIA - AN AGRARIAN ECONOMY



An agrarian economy is an economy where a majority portion of the income of individuals is made from agriculture. India has a significant agricultural sector and could be considered agrarian.

While agriculture's share in India's economy has progressively declined to less than 15% due to the high growth rates of the industrial and services sectors, the sector's importance in India's economic and social fabric goes well beyond this indicator. First, nearly three-quarters of India's families depend on rural incomes. Second, the majority of India's poor (some 770 million people or about 70 percent) are found in rural areas. And third, India's food security depends on producing cereal crops, as well as increasing its production of fruits, vegetables and milk to meet the demands of a growing population with rising incomes. To do so, a productive, competitive, diversified and sustainable agricultural sector will need to emerge at an accelerated pace.

India is a global agricultural powerhouse. It is the world's largest producer of milk, pulses, and spices, and has the world's largest cattle herd (buffaloes), as well as the largest area under wheat, rice and cotton. It is the second largest producer of rice, wheat, cotton, sugarcane, farmed fish, sheep & goat meat, fruit, vegetables and tea.





BUNDELKHAND - LAND OF OPPORTUNITIES

All the concerned districts of Bundelkhand have their economy predominantly based on agriculture. But the infertility of land, low productivity, improper land distribution in which a few medium and large farmers have major share in land holdings, lack of irrigation facilities and unscientific cultivation in terms of non-use of modern methods in agriculture have kept the agriculture-based economy on the verge of subsistence only. In MP Bundelkhand, percentage of total irrigated land in is higher than the state average, at nearly 40% of total sown land.

However, none of the districts of MP Bundelkhand rank among MP's top districts in the yield of any crop, due to factors such as soil quality, use of fertilizers and seed replacement rate. Damoh, located in the heart of Bundelkhand, is a strategically crucial region for our program due to its location. With most of the population directly or indirectly dependent on agriculture, Bundelkhand and its surrounding areas, holds considerable potential for agricultural expansion and improvement. Despite its agricultural significance, the region is lagging in technical agricultural practices, Thus have a significant opportunity for impactful intervention.
